

- 9. Students will be permitted for temporary discontinuation only after completion of the course work, comprehensive exam and *viva voce*.

- 2. Decide a broad title of research within 01-16 Mar, 2022 and choose II semester courses accordingly
- 3. Minor courses for **second semester** need to be selected in consultation with the Advisory Committee
