Introduction

India is bestowed with enormous freshwater aquatic resources in the form of rivers, lakes, reservoirs, ponds, tanks, *beels* and oxbow lakes. In addition to that freshwater species biodiversity in Indian ecosystems is also huge. Fish culture has emerged as one of the high earning and commercial venture with lot of expansion opportunities.
