## GENESIS OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT CERTIFICATE COURSE

The absence of qualified technical staff in the hatcheries and aquaculture farms is having its cascading affect on the aquaculture in the entire country, as the hatcheries has to supply the fish/ shrimp seed to aqua farmers and in turn aquaculture has to produce the fish as per the requirement of the growing populations. In view of these a year-long certificate course in 'Fish Farming and Hatchery operation' is being introduced for the first of its kind by the ICAR-Central Institute of Fisheries Education (CIFE), the certificate course is expected to provide qualified manpower to the aquaculture industry in the years to come

# **Skill Development Certificate Course Details**

The duration of the certificate course is one year. The course consists of theory, practical and field visits. During the one year the students will be taught about the basics of fish farming and hatchery operations and the different areas covered by the course are as follows:

- 1. Principles of aquaculture
- 2. Soil and water quality management in aquaculture
- 3. Management of farm machinery
- 4. Freshwater aquaculture
- 5. Brackish water aquaculture
- 6. Feeding and feed management in aquaculture
- 7. Shellfish hatchery management
- 8. Harvest and post-harvest management

**<u>Eligibility</u>**: 10<sup>th</sup> pass from recognized board of India (ICSE, CBSE, SSC, IB).

Age: 16-45 years

Course Fee: The fees will be Rs 11,100 /- including Tuition fees, Hostel charges & Evaluation fees.
