## Report on Skill Development Programme on "Application of Zebrafish as Vertebrate Model for Biomedical Studies, 23<sup>rd</sup> Feb to 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2021"

The Skill Development Programme on "Application of Zebrafish as Vertebrate Model for Biomedical Studies" was conducted during 23rd Feb to 5th March 2021 at FGB Division, ICAR-CIFE. Dr Aparna Chaudhari was the Course Director, and Dr N. S. Nagpure and Dr Mujahidkhan A. Pathan were the Coordinators. The program was inaugurated by Dr Gopal Krishna, Director, ICAR-CIFE. Six participants from Haffkine Institute, Bombay Pharmacy College, ACTREC and MGM Medical College, Mumbai, attended the training program. All the participants use zebrafish as a model in their research. The topics included various applications of zebrafish as a vertebrate model, husbandry, breeding, embryogenesis and early development, genetic management of zebrafish, water quality management, disease surveillance in the culture facility, histology, *in vivo* and *in vitro* toxicity assays, microinjection of DNA into zebrafish embryos, transfection into cell lines, along with basic molecular biology techniques.
