

Press Release of Garib Kaylan Sammelan organized on 31st May 2022

Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi to interact with beneficiaries of public welfare scheme

- Garib Kalyan Sammelan was organized across the country on the occasion of completion of eight years of the Modi government
- It was witness elected public representatives across the country directly interacting with the public.
- PM to interact with the beneficiaries of programmes of nine Union Ministries/ Departments
- PM to also released the 11th instalment of PM-KISAN
- More than 2000 beneficiaries and around 1000 fish farmers participated in the programme.

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi visited Shimla, Himachal Pradesh 31st May 2022 and participated in the 'Garib Kalyan Sammelan'. This novel public programme marking completion of eight years of the government led by the Prime Minister and which was organized across the country at State Capitals, District Headquarters and Krishi Vigyan Kendras. The Sammelan conceptualizes elected public representatives across the country directly interacting with the public in an endeavour to get feedback about the various welfare programmes being run by the government.

'Garib Kalyan Sammelan' started at around 09:45 AM with Chief Ministers, Central Ministers, State Ministers, Members of Parliament, Members of Legislative Assembly and other elected public representatives directly interacting with the public at their respective locations across the country. Prime Minister emphasis various schemes runs through the government of India and briefed about the details about the beneficiaries and he emphasis the nation to make self-dependent (Atmanirbhar Bharat) with underlining the technical and medical education in national and local languages.

In Mumbai, Hon'ble Union Minister of State, Panchayat Raj, Shri Kapil Moreshwar Patil and Shree Devendra Fadnavis, Ex- Chief Ministers and Leader of Opposition in Maharashtra Legislative Assembly. Shri Chandrakant Dada Patil, Ex- Minister of PWD & Revenue, GoM, Shree Gopal Shetty M. Member of Parliament Ji directly interacted with more than 2000 beneficiaries of various public welfare schemes (Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana Urban, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi, Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana, POSHAN Abhiyan, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana, Swachh Bharat Mission, Jal Jeevan Mission & AMRUT, Pradhan Mantri SVANidhi Scheme, One Nation One Ration Card, Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana, Ayushman Bharat PM Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY), Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centre and Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana) and 1000 Fish farmers at BPCL Refinery Sports Club, Mumbai.



At about 11:25 AM, with the Prime Minister joined the programme. During the Sammelan, Prime Minister directly interacted with the beneficiaries of different programmes of nine Ministries / Departments of the Government of India.

The freewheeling interaction organized across the country was aimed to get free and frank feedback from the public, understand the impact of welfare schemes in people's lives and explore convergence and saturation with regard to different government programmes. The endeavour is to make the reach and delivery of government programmes more efficient so as to improve the ease of living of the citizens of the country.

Prime Minister also released the 11th instalment of financial benefit under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) scheme. This will enable the transfer of an amount of around Rs. 21,000 Crore to more than 10 Crore beneficiary farmer families. On the occasion, Prime Minister also interacted with the beneficiaries of (PM-KISAN) across the country.

More than 1000 fish farmers also attended the Garib Kalyan Sammelan and all fish farmers along with beneficiaries of various scheme were very much inspired with address of Prime Minister Shree Shri Narendra Modi ji. Programme was jointly organised by Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited, ICAR-Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai, ICAR-Central Institute for Research on Cotton Technology, Mumbai at BPL Sports Complex Mumbai.
