

## **TSP- TRAINING REPORT**

### **Awareness cum Training Programme on Fish culture for Tribal Farmers of Palghar District, Maharashtra**

Division of Aquaculture, ICAR- Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai organized an Awareness cum training programme on fish culture under Tribal Sub plan (TSP), Govt of India at Rajshri Shahu Maharaj Ashramshala, Adoshi, Khodala, Mokhada, District Palghar, Maharashtra on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2019. The programme was conducted in association with The Energy and Resources Institute, TERI. A total of 61 participants from 4 villages attended the programme. The lectures and discussions covered were: the importance of fish culture in rural livelihood and sustainable use of resources for aquaculture, importance of site and species selection in aquaculture, importance of soil and water quality and management measures in fish culture. The participants were given a bilingual manual (in English and Marathi) on Fish Farming Techniques. A field visit to the nearby farm was also arranged for the participants.
