Awareness cum Skill Development Programme on “**Genetic Broodstock Management of Common carp**” under TSP project held at KVK-Senapati, Hengbung, Manipur during 16th to 18th February, 2023

ICAR-Central Institute of Fisheries Education (CIFE), Mumbai in collaboration with KVK-Senapati, Hengbung, Manipur organized a three days Awareness cum Skill Development Programme on “**Genetic Broodstock Management of Common carp**” at KVK-Senapati, Hengbung during 16th to 18th Feb., 2023 and the programme was concluded successfully. A total of 50 farmers from Senapati and Kangpokpi district attended the training programme. The program was inaugurated in the presence of Dr. N. Joshna, Head and Senior Scientist, KVK-Senapati. Mr. Angom Lenin Singh, Coordinator of the training program gave a brief about the program. A training manual on “Genetic Broodstock management of Common carp” was also released to help the farmers for practicing at field. Other Resource persons for the training programme were Dr. Hoilenting (SMS-Fisheries), Mr. S. Gojendro Singh (Scientist ICAR-RC NEH, Meghalaya), Dr. Ch. Baru Singh (Asso. Prof. PDDUIAS, Manipur) and Mr. Wanglemba (Director, ENGAL-Aquaculture Pvt. Ltd.). The rationale of the program was to give hands on expertise on induce breeding and brooder management of common carp. The fish farmers in these mentioned districts are facing problem on getting quality fish seeds due to poor transportation, hilly region and far away from the seed producing valley areas. Due to improper broodstock management and cold climate condition, availability of good quality and quantity seed is of major issue. After a prior communications with the farmer communities, broodstock management was chosen as the topic. Several sessions were taken on Broodstock management, induced breeding, nursery management and fish culture in semi hilly region. Further hands on experience on induce breeding of Common carps in hatchery were deliberated. The program was concluded successfully with positive feedback from farmers.
