Interaction of Experts with the Farmers on Last Thursday of each Month भारी के अंतिम बृहस्पतिवारः मन की बात मत्स्य किसान के साथ"

The ICAR-CIFE RRTC Motipur Centre successfully conducted the programme "Interaction of Experts with Farmers on the Last Thursday of Each Month," known in Hindi as "महीने के अंतिम बृहस्पतिवार: मन की बात मत्स्य किसान के साथ," on September 26, 2024, starting at 3:00 PM. The event was held in both physical and online formats, with the online session accessible via meet.google.com/rpc-ygyg-ifj.

This initiative was implemented following a suggestion from Dr. Udham Singh Gautam, Deputy Director General, Agricultural Extension, Division of Agricultural Extension, Krishi Anusandhan Bhawan, New Delhi. It aligns with the Honourable Prime Minister's initiative to engage agricultural experts with farmers, as highlighted during the release of 109 crop varieties developed by ICAR on August 11, 2024, at the ICAR-IARI Research Farm in PUSA, New Delhi. The Prime Minister emphasized the importance of monthly interactions between experts from KVK, ICAR, and SAUs and farmers, designating the last Thursday of each month for this purpose.

The primary objective of this session was to inform farmers about the "Prospects of Aquaculture in Bihar and Jharkhand: The Role of ICAR-CIFE in Enhancing Production." Accordingly, in this programme, the ICAR-CIFE team made continuous efforts to address various concerns raised by fish farmers through mutual learning.

A total number of 60 fish farmers from various regions of Bihar and Jharkhand participated in the programme in physical mode and 63 attendees joined online. Among these, 21 participants were KVK personnel from various districts including Begusarai, Narkatiyaganj, Lada, Piparkothi, Sheohar, Sukhet, Banka, Latehar, Arwal, Dhanbad, Nawada, Sariakela, Sitamarhi, Sahibganj, Lakhisarai, Gopalganj, Lohardaga, Jamtara, Munger, Madhopur, Katihar, and West Champaran. Additionally, representatives from the private company Mamta Aqua (Vaishali, Bihar), King Fisheries (Ranchi, Jharkhand), Jasauli agro farm (Jasauli, Motipur, Bihar) also benefited from the programme.

The programme commenced with a formal introduction of the technical experts from ICAR-CIFE, Mumbai, ICAR-CIFE, Motipur, and the KVK personnel. The technical session, chaired by Dr. Md. Aklakur, focused on the theme "Prospects of Aquaculture in Bihar and Jharkhand and the Role of ICAR-CIFE in Enhancing Production". He emphasized the importance of utilizing natural water resources for employment generation through aquaculture and stressed the urgent need for self-reliance in aquaculture to meet the local fish demand in Bihar and Jharkhand. He further highlighted ICAR-CIFE's contribution to advanced aquaculture technologies, such as Recirculating Aquaculture Systems (RAS), Biofloc technology, and Integrated Farming Systems, which have been demonstrated in various parts of the region. He also extended an invitation to the farmers to join hands with ICAR-CIFE for technical assistance and to improve their aquaculture practices.

Following the technical discussion, an interactive session was held with the farmers, who participated actively and energetically. Several day-to-day challenges faced by the farmers were discussed, and experts from ICAR-CIFE provided practical solutions and guidance. The panel of experts included:
