



NFDB Funded Long Duration Skill Development Program
on Aquaculture Technician (27/6/2018 to 21/7/2018)



About the Program

NFDB sponsored **Skill Development Program on Aquaculture Technician** will be implemented at ICAR-CIFE Rohtak centre. The course will consist of theory classes, practical classes and field visits to the farms located in and around Rohtak. The program is designed to produce trained manpower to act as aquaculture technicians on fish and shrimp farms spread across the country.

The course will have modules on

- I. Pre-stocking management in fish and shrimp Farming
- II. Post stocking management in fish and shrimp farming
- III. Disease management, emergency response and personal safety and hygiene in aquaculture.

On the successful completion of program participants will be provided with a certificate of participation.

No of participants- Limited to 25

Duration of the Program- 27/6/2018-21/7/2018

Eligibility- Anyone who is able to read and write is eligible to attend the program. Medium of instruction for the program is Hindi.

TA and DA- Participants do not need to pay any fee to attend this program. They will be provided free boarding and lodging. Travelling allowance will be provided to the participants for the actual to and fro fare restricted to 2nd class railway fare up to an amount of Rs. 500 per participant.

About the Centre- ICAR-CIFE Rohtak centre is one of the regional research centers of ICAR-Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai with a unique distinction of being the only research centre in India dedicated to research on use of inland saline soils and underground saline water for fish and shrimp farming. About 37 ha of farm area demarcated into low and high saline areas is available at Baniyani and Lahli suitable for species that need either low or

high salinity for reproduction and culture. The Centre has a Soil and Water Testing Lab, a microbiology lab, a hatchery for production of 5 million post-larvae of scampi, a Wet Lab and a training hall with audio visual aids to accommodate 25 trainees. Over the years centre has developed several aquaculture technologies and demonstrated the same for the commercial utilization of saline affected resources.

Location- Rohtak is well connected with rail and road. Centre is located at a distance of about 12 kms from the railway station and 18 kms from the New Bus Stand. Participants after reaching railway station or bus stand can reach the centre by hiring individual or share auto.
