- All the students are required to complete a training/internship for 30 days in any research institute/university/industry/farm in the area related to the Dissertation work. They need to undergo the training during II year with the approval of guide and HoD, before start of research work.
- The report on training needs to be submitted to the HoD within 15 days after completion of the training.

- Courses for II semester need to be selected in consultation with the Advisory Committee
- Students who are away from the Institute for field work/research training may register by submitting Registration Form along with copy of fee receipt and progress report to academiccell@cife.edu.in
- The synopsis cannot be modified unless recommended by the Board of Studies
- For signatures of advisory members who are not present in the institute, written consent for submitting the dissertation may be obtained by e-mail
- Dissertation submitted after due date (15/7/2022) viva-voce shall be conducted on later dates and the Dean's Office/Examination Cell will not be responsible for the timely declaration of the final result. This is to be strictly adhered and followed.**
