### Words of Caution...

1. Late registration will be allowed only after due approval from Dean (Academic) and the Director
2. Penalty of Rs.500/- per day will be charged from the 4<sup>th</sup> day till the 10<sup>th</sup> day of registration. Thereafter, no registration will be entertained
3. 85% attendance is compulsory, failing which the student is not permitted to appear for examinations
4. Fellowship will be disbursed only to the registered students.
5. The passing marks of each paper as per CGPA and OGPA are 6.0 and 6.5 respectively.
6. The passing marks for comprehensive exam is 60% in each paper.
7. The synopsis can not be modified unless recommended by the Board of Studies after the recommendations of the major guide.
8. Thesis can only be submitted after **two** academic years from the date of synopsis approval and fulfilment of **three** academic years residential period and other formalities.
9. Students will be permitted for temporary discontinuation only after completion of the course work, comprehensive exam and *viva voce*.

### Important instructions...

1. Strictly adhere to the schedule as mentioned in the calendar
2. Decide a broad title of research **within** 1-16 Feb, 2021 and choose II semester courses accordingly
3. Minor courses for **second semester** need to be selected in consultation with the Advisory Committee
4. The synopsis should be submitted on or before 15 June 2021.
