The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) is an Apex Organization at National level for public research in agriculture including livestock and fisheries. It is a central autonomous body under the Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE) in the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare. It is fully funded by Government of India.

1. ICAR - Central Institute of Fisheries Education (CIFE), Mumbai was established in the year 1961 under the Ministry of Agriculture, Govt. of India with the assistance of FAO/UNDP. It came under the Administrative control of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi in 1979. The Institute was conferred the status of Deemed University in March 1989. The Institute has a mandate to conduct post-graduate (M. F. Sc.) and Doctoral courses (Ph.D.) in core and emerging disciplines of Fisheries Science. ICAR-CIFE is also mandated to undertake basic and strategic research in frontier areas of fisheries, conduct demand-driven training programmes to various stake-holders, and to provide inputs for policy development. In over 50 years of its existence, ICAR-CIFE has emerged as a center of excellence for higher education in fisheries and allied disciplines and has nurtured many illustrious scholars and leaders. Today, CIFE takes pride in its elegant and expansive campus comprising of state of art laboratories, library, hostels, guest house, and sports facility.

The Regional Research and Training Centre (RRTC) of ICAR-CIFE in the premises of Regional Centre of Indian Institute of Sugarcane Research (IISR), Motipur came into existence on 10.09.2018. The mandate of RRTC, Motipur is to impart education and training to fish farmers, entrepreneurs, and other stakeholders. Since it is a new center of ICAR-CIFE, basic infrastructural facilities are to be created for smooth functioning of the office and conducting educational programmes and hands on training for HRD in fisheries. In this regard, three following works have been approved by ICAR, of which (i) and (ii) are under progress and (iii) has been approved and in 2019-20 up to a total cost of Rs. 85 lakhs.

- (i) Construction of Office-cum-Training Hall
- (ii) Construction of Fish Ponds/Concrete Tanks
- (iii) **Road and street lighting, Transformer, Electrical wiring, Bore-well and Water supply**

Therefore, the Director / Vice-Chancellor, ICAR - Central Institute of Fisheries Education (CIFE), Mumbai on behalf of Secretary, ICAR, New Delhi invites **“Expression of Interest”** (E.O.I.) from Public Sector Undertakings set up by the Central or State Govt. to carry out civil or electrical works or any other Central or State Govt. organization / Public Sector Undertaking which may be notified by Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) for planning, designing, and construction/developmental works, **namely “Road and street lighting, Transformer, Electrical wiring, Bore-well and Water supply” at Regional**

Research and Training Centre (RRTC) of ICAR-CIFE, Motipur, Bihar as per Rule 133 (3) of the GFR 2017. The estimated cost of the work is about **Rs. 85.00 lakhs.**

3. Scope of work

- 3.1** Site survey, preparation of Design, Layout plan, Estimate, and Construction/developmental works namely **“Road and street lighting, Transformer, Electrical wiring, Bore-well and Water supply”** at **Regional Research and Training Centre (RRTC) of ICAR-CIFE, Motipur, Bihar** at an estimated cost of Estimated Cost of **Rs. 85.00 lakhs.**
- 3.2** Preparation of layout plan, complete design, drawing, estimation of cost, and construction / development of following approved buildings / facilities / works within the SFC allocation / sanctioned amount (Rs. 85.00 lakhs) shall be done in accordance with the approved Master Plan of the Center (i.e. RRTC, Motipur) in consultation with Director, CIFE, Mumbai and as per details given below:
- 3.2.1** Internal roads wherever required shall be designed and constructed as per CPWD specifications. Water disposal system in the form of open channels should be constructed on the sides of the road.
- 3.2.2** Street lighting, electrical wiring, fittings, installations, and transformer shall be in accordance with CPWD specifications and shall meet ISI standards.
- 3.2.3** Bore-well should be constructed in accordance with standard CPWD specifications. Design & construction of bore-well should include installation of suitable pumping unit, pump-house, and other requisite accessories. Water supply system should be well designed so as to supply water to all buildings, ponds, tanks etc.
- 3.2.4** Design of all these facilities should be made in consultation with Officer-In-Charge, RRTC, Motipur. A copy of the approved Master Plan of the campus is enclosed for ready reference
- 3.2.5** The constructions should confirm to green building concept/norms to achieve at least 80% rating. A tentative layout plan of office building/Training hall is enclosed for ready reference.

- 33** The selected PSU / organization will undertake to plan, design and execute the work in its totality including, general architecture, structural design of the building, electrical design, energy conservation architecture, air-conditioning — photo thermal cooling or based on renewable source of energy, quantity surveying — civil, electrical, air conditioning, interior architecture, water supply design, water harvesting design, acoustics design, waste water treatment design, lighting design, sound system design, firefighting system, horticultural/ landscaping features, liaison work for obtaining required regulatory statutory clearances and any other work which may crop up during the design. This is only illustrative and by no means an exhaustive list of the functions.
- 34** The selected organization will undertake all operation and maintenance functions (Civil, Electrical, Refrigeration and other related aspects) of buildings / facilities built by them for a period of 3 years including the defect liability period of one year. The fund for operation and maintenance work are not the part of the estimated cost of **Rs. 85.00 lakhs;** however, a separate proposal for the same has to be got approved by PMC agency from the institute.

4. Who can apply?

To be eligible for consideration for award of the work, an organization should have:

- 41** Planned and executed the similar type of works of **at least one work of Rs. 80 lakhs or two works each of Rs. 60 lakhs or three works each of Rs. 40 lakhs** for a Government organization in the last five years.
- 42** Average annual financial turnover from Consultancy Works of not less than **Rs. 1 crore per annum** ending 31st March of the previous financial year.
- 43** Average annual financial turnover from the Contract Value of not less than **Rs. 1 crore per annum** during the last 3 years ending 31st March of the previous financial year.
- 44** On its rolls on full time basis there should be adequate number of competent civil, structural, electrical, air conditioning engineers/ architects to plan/design/execute the work. Applicants who do not have such staff on its rolls and plan to hire for this purpose may clearly so state (Minimum 50 strength).
- 45** The prospective bidder should be an **ISO-9001-2000** accredited company.
- 46** A minimum of ten years of experience in rendering PMC service for works.
- 47** Public Works Departments such as CPWD, State Public Works departments, other Central Government Organizations that carry out civil or electrical works such as Military Engineering

Service (MES), Border Roads Organization (BRO), etc. or Ministry/Department's construction wings of Ministries of Railways, Defense Environment & Forests, Information & Broadcasting and Departments of Posts and Space etc. Any Public Sector Unit (PSU) / Public Sector Organizations.

5. How to apply:

The agencies will have to submit EOI in the prescribed format along with supportive documents in a two-bid systems and upload on **www.eprocure.gov.in**:

- (i) Technical Bid
- (ii) Financial Bid

Each of these Bids is to be put in separate sealed envelope, clearly subscribed **-Technical Bid** and **"Financial Bid,"** respectively.

Both these sealed envelopes shall be put in one sealed envelope (Containing Address, Name and Contact No.) subscribed **-EOI for Project Management Consultancy Services** for construction of **"Road and street lighting, Transformer, Electrical wiring, Bore- well and Water supply"** at **Regional Research and Training Centre (RRTC) of ICAR- CIFE, Motipur, Bihar.**

5.1. Technical Bids: The details to be furnished in technical bids are:

5.1.1 Annexure-I

The basic information / profile of the PSU / organization along with the organizational chart / organogram of the organization. The details of Registration / accreditation of the PSU / organization. Years of experience as PMC agency.

5.1.2 Annexure-II

Financial status, turnover during the preceding 3 years. Company's audited balance sheet of the preceding 3 years.

5.1.3 Annexure-III

Details of technical manpower, total strength of the organization giving break-up of specialists i.e. engineers, quality surveyors, etc. with their qualification & experience

5.1.4 Annexure-IV

List of similar works costing **more than 1 crore** executed during the last ten years.

5.1.5 Annexure-V

Details of works executed costing **more than 1.0 crore** or more confirming to GRIHA-III or equivalent to LEED Rating.

5.2 Financial Bid:

The financial bid for the above scope of work shall be submitted in prescribed format at Annexure-VI (as uploaded on www.eprocure.gov.in), and should be signed by the authorized signatory of the agency. The financial bids must indicate **Lumpsum service charges for execution of work including all prevailing taxes as per the Rule 133 (3) of GFR 2017. The quoted lumpsum service charges shall be inclusive of all Government taxes / service charges etc. No extra payment on this account will be paid by the Institute.**

6.0 Evaluation Method of Shortlisting the PMC Agencies

The employer will evaluate the technical bids and presentation of shortlisting the agencies. The evaluation for the technical bid and presentation will be based on the following criteria:

6.3. After evaluation of technical bid and presentation, the agencies scoring 75 marks and more than 75 marks will be qualified for opening of the financial bids.

7.0 Opening of the financial bid

The financial bid of qualified bidders as indicated in Para 6.3 will be opened by a committee in presence of authorized representatives of the qualified bidders. The agency quoting the lowest lumpsum fee will be recommended for award of the work. The decision of the Committee shall be final and binding.

8.0 Agreement:

The selected PMC has to execute an agreement for the execution of the work on a non- judicial stamp paper of the prescribed value.

9.0 Tender Validity:

The tender shall be valid for a **period of 180 days** from the due date for submission of tender

10.0 Earnest Money Deposit

The bidder has to accept and sign Bid Securing Declaration as per Annexure-VIII

11.0 Security Deposit

The successful bidder has to deposit 10% of the quoted amount (i.e. consultancy fees) towards Security Deposit in the form of Demand draft / Bank Guarantee / Any other Govt. approved / prescribed procedure. In case of Demand Draft, the demand draft should be made in favour of **“ICAR Unit – CIFE” payable at Mumbai.**

12.0: Completion of Project:

The project should be completed in **6 months** from the date of award of work

13.0 General:

- (a) Parties desirous of visiting the site can do so between 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days
- (b) ICAR-CIFE reserves the right to accept / reject any or all tenders / offers without assigning any reason thereof.
- (c) In case the cost of project increase due to increase in the scope of the work or any other reasons, no extra PMC lumpsum service charges over and above the quoted PMC lumpsum service charges will be admissible.
- (d) If any dispute, decision of the Secretary, ICAR shall be final and binding to all parties.
